

Reporters Turn to Fisher Phillips for Insight into Supreme Court Nominee's Record

In search of signs for whether President Trump's Supreme Court nominee, Brett Kavanaugh, would favor employers, the media turned to Fisher Phillips. Reporters with <u>The Wall Street Journal</u> (WSJ), <u>Law 360</u>, <u>HR Executive Magazine</u> and <u>The National Law Journal</u> interviewed Rich Meneghello regarding his <u>analysis</u> of Kavanaugh's record. Specifically, Rich told the WSJ: In some other cases he appeared to "bend over backwards" to side with employers. One of those cases involved a former employer sending negative information about a former employee to that person's new company, in violation of the terms of their separation agreement.
