



Irvine Attorney Discusses Supreme Court Remanding of Mandatory Bar Dues Case

In the *Daily Journal* article “US Supreme Court remands challenge to mandatory bar dues,” Irvine partner Colin P. Calvert discusses the U.S. Supreme Court’s decision to remand *Fleck v. Wetch*, a case that challenged mandatory bar membership, back to the 8th Circuit to reconsider the case in light of the *Janus v. AFSCME* ruling.

Colin believed the mandatory fees issue in the *Fleck* case aren’t analogous to the union dues issue in *Janus*. Colin says the potential for disruption in the legal industry “minimizes the likelihood the Court will extend the *Janus* ruling to *Fleck*.”
