

Louisville Partner Shares Her Insights on How the Pandemic Might Impact Kentucky's Wage Gap

In a televised interview with *Spectrum News* in Louisville, **Emily Litzinger** weighs-in on Kentucky's gender wage gap and how the pandemic may exacerbate the disparity in pay among men and women. Emily explains that the pandemic has created a situation in which fewer qualified women are remaining in the workforce, and those that will later re-enter the workforce will be at greater risk of making less money than their male counterparts. She notes that the great strides toward pay equity are now at risk of falling by the wayside as economists are projecting that the pandemic is only going to widen the already-existing pay gap among men and women.
