

Workplace Safety Co-Chair Discusses Recordkeeping Requirements Associated with OSHA's Emergency Temporary Standard

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In an interview with *Bloomberg Law*, **Todd Logsdon** discusses the recordkeeping requirements associated with OSHA's Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS), which sets new COVID-19 mandates for healthcare employers. Todd explains that the ETS sets a new threshold for when an employer must inform OSHA of a COVID-19 death or hospitalization. The article describes that "employers will be required to report each work-related COVID-19 fatality or in-patient hospitalization no matter the amount of time between the workplace exposure and the death or hospitalization."
